To better educate our high-potential leaders in banking and to provide Montana banks with a valuable professional development opportunity, Pacific Coast Banking School partners with Montana Bankers Association (MBA) to offer a tuition scholarship for the 2021 Resident or Virtual Session of Pacific Coast Banking School (PCBS).

THE PCBS PROGRAM

Since 1938, Pacific Coast Banking School, in partnership with the Foster School of Business at the University of Washington, has offered a premier three-year graduate-level leadership and financial management education program focused on the banking industry. The PCBS family includes over 20,000 bankers, with hundreds currently in key leadership roles in banks across the country. Premier instructors and cutting-edge curriculum offer practical answers to today's most critical banking dilemmas faced by bankers from all aspects of banking and all sizes of banks.

SCHOLARSHIP SESSION

Students enroll in a three-year program, which includes a two-week session each August for three years held on the University of Washington campus. The 2021 session dates are August 22^{nd} through September 3^{rd} if in person or August 15^{th} - 27^{th} if virtual.

THE PROCESS

Tuition before the scholarship is applied is \$5,750, which includes a non-refundable registration fee of \$350, single room accommodations, most meals and classes, along with administrative and faculty support for intersession work. The scholarship amount is **\$2,200** and is applicable to the first-year 2020 PCBS tuition only. The scholarship recipient is responsible for the \$3,550 tuition balance. Details subject to change if required to have the session held virtually.

The deadline for submitting scholarship applications to the MBA is **May 1, 2021**. Nominees must also submit a PCBS application. Qualifying applications will be forwarded to the Scholarship Review Committee, and nominees will be informed of the Committee's decision by May 15, 2021.

CANDIDATE PRE-REQUISITES

The scholarship nominee must complete:

- 1 The PCBS 2021 Session Application
- 2 The PCBS/ MBA Scholarship Application

These forms must be submitted by May 1, 2021.

Please submit the completed Pacific Coast Banking School 2021 Session Application along with this completed Scholarship Application. It can be found at www.ThePCBS.org under Educational Resources / Scholarships.

Nominee must meet PCBS prerequisites of five years banking experience and basic competencies in accounting, corporate finance and economics. Nominations will be accepted until **May 1, 2021** by the Montana Bankers Association. Qualifying applications will be forwarded to the Scholarship Review Committee, and nominees will be informed of the Committee's decision by May15, 2021. Nominees must submit both a PCBS application and a scholarship application before consideration.

One \$2,200 scholarship is offered for a first year student. The tuition balance after scholarship funds are applied is \$3,550. Tuition includes a non-refundable processing fee, classes, most meals, and single-room accommodations for the two-week resident session, and administrative and faculty support for intersession work. All details are subject to change if session is required to go virtual.
