## **PACIFIC COAST BANKING SCHOOL and OBA EDUCATION FOUNDATION 'RISE ABOVE THE REST' SCHOLARSHIP**

To better educate our high-potential leaders in banking and to provide Oregon banks with a valuable professional development opportunity, Pacific Coast Banking School partners with OBA Education Foundation, founded by the Oregon Bankers Association, to offer a tuition scholarship for the 2021 Session of Pacific Coast Banking School (PCBS).

### **THE PCBS PROGRAM**

Since 1938, Pacific Coast Banking School, in partnership with the Foster School of Business at the University of Washington, has offered a premier three year graduate-level leadership and financial management education program focused on the banking industry. The PCBS family includes over 20,000 bankers, with hundreds currently in key leadership roles in banks across the country. Premier instructors and cutting-edge curriculum offer practical answers to today's most critical banking dilemmas faced by bankers from all aspects of banking and all sizes of banks.

### **SCHOLARSHIP SESSION**

Students enroll in a three-year program, which includes a two-week resident session each August for three years. The 2021 session dates in person are August 22<sup>nd</sup> - September 3<sup>rd</sup> or virtually August 15-27<sup>th</sup>.

### **THE PROCESS**

Tuition before the scholarship is applied is \$5,750, which includes a non-refundable registration fee of \$350, single room accommodations, most meals, and classes, along with administrative and faculty support for intersession work. Details subject to change if required to have the session held virtually. The scholarship amount is **\$1,500** and is applicable to each year of PCBS tuition for all three years. The scholarship recipient is responsible for the tuition balance.

The deadline for submitting scholarship applications to the OBA Education Foundation is **May 1, 2021**. Nominees must also submit a PCBS application. Qualifying applications will be forwarded to the Scholarship Review Committee, and nominees will be informed of the Committee's decision by May 15, 2021.

### **CANDIDATE PRE-REQUISITES**

The scholarship nominee must complete:

- 1 – The PCBS 2021 Session Application
- 2 – The PCBS/OBA Education Foundation Scholarship Application

These forms must be submitted by May 1, 2021.

Qualifying applications will be forwarded to the Scholarship Review Committee, and nominees will be informed of the Committee's decision by May 15, 2021. Nominees must submit both a PCBS application and a scholarship application before consideration.

One \$1,500 scholarship is offered for each of the three years. The tuition balance is the responsibility of the student and/or their institution. This amount includes a non-refundable processing fee, classes, meals, and single-room accommodations for the two-week resident session, and administrative and faculty support for intersession work. Details subject to change if it will be required to hold the session virtually.
